Our approach

We're innovators who believe in collaboration, problem solving and a inventive approach to solving traditional construction problems.

Our solutions, developed in response to airport sector requirements, are suitable for a wide range of applications, including in the general security, military and defence, and humanitarian arenas.

As a responsible company, we believe that the design phase of any project is our opportunity to consider the whole life cycle and impact we may have on our planet for future generations.

ACS is committed to providing intelligent solutions and the use of 'green' initiatives throughout our supply chain.

The unique design of our products enables the energy usage for a facility to be significantly reduced by containing the screening machines and controlling temperatures within. Where traditionally, the whole facility needs to be temperature controlled to maintain the optimum environment for the machines, we only heat and cool the space required for the machine to perform. The result is a huge reduction in the specification, cost and environmental impact of the equipment required to keep the machines in their operational envelope.

The design and construction of our buildings means that they are reusable, refittable and redeployable, giving our clients excellent value for money, and helping to reduce unnecessary construction waste. Even better, our approach promotes better site health, safety and wellbeing. Our work entirely removes the need for excavation or working at height, and we need fewer constructors on site, reducing downtime and ensuring we meet even the tightest of deadlines.

Case study:

HEATHROW BAGGAGE RECONCILIATION FACILITY

ACS

The Challenge

Heathrow Airport had an urgent requirement to provide a stand-alone Baggage Handling Facility in the heart of its live Operations at Terminal 5. The requirement was for a building with dimensions of 120M x 40M housing 2 lines of Standard 3 Hold Baggage Screening feeding 2 flight build carousels. The timeframe available to design, manufacture, install, test and commission was 21 weeks, and this had to be completed in a live Operational environment, in very close proximity to 4 x Code F Aircraft Stands and 2 x Passenger Link Bridges that had to remain open at all times.

The Solution

By utilising our modular Baggage Handling and Building Systems, we were able to reduce the scheme and production design phases down to a total of 8 weeks. In parallel, because we use standard modular componentry, we were able to order and manufacture our long lead items to reduce delivery time to the minimum. Our patented baggageBoX system was manufactured, tested and commissioned completely off-site, meaning that the complex HBS integration issues were resolved prior to any equipment arriving on site. This offsite working allowed the complex build programme to be collapsed even further with the facility ultimately being delivered for beneficial use a full 8 days ahead of programme.



The Benefits

This Project was a brand new method of Project delivery for Heathrow Airport. It allowed the Airport to realise a fully functional Baggage Handling Facility in a fraction of the time and cost of a traditional design and build. The team was mobilised instantly and as a turnkey delivery, we were able to control all aspects of the works in the most efficient way whilst working closely with the Client team to ensure Operations were able to continue with business as usual.

This approach to project delivery has gone on record as being one of the most successful example of project delivery in the history of Heathrow Airport and is something we are extremely proud of.


Archie's August Disco Ball!
