World-class expertise

SPE Offshore Europe unites knowledge, expertise, and technology to drive progress towards the future of energy. This huge, well-renowned event is unmissable for everyone working in offshore energy: this year, more than 700 exhibitors hosted stands and demonstrations for thousands of visitors.

2023 is the 50th anniversary of the event, which is held in Aberdeen in alternate years (bringing a £50 million cash injection to the local hospitality industry).



It was TEXO's first time exhibiting at Offshore Europe," says Brand Executive Alan Conway. "These big stands are set up to show how good the companies are at engineering and fabrication, but we wanted to do something different."

"We had the idea to focus on the TEXO Foundation and our charitable work," he explains. "So we called it the TEXO Foundation Village. Across the back wall we had a story about all of our locations – Westhill, Dundee, Port of Blyth, Northampton and Witham – and showed how in each place we linked with a school or a community cause to work with the community groups who need it."

"We talked about things we've organised, like the TEXO community challenge cup in Cross Park, and players and teams we've sponsored, like boxers Tommy Hodgson and Dean Sutherland."

Special guests

On day 3, TEXO welcomed special guests who are all linked to the Foundation. At lunchtime, players from the male and female Aberdeen FC teams held a penalty shoot-out where visitors could win prizes including a signed shirt, sweets, and memorabilia.

Later, local legend Dean Sutherland did a meet-and-greet, and Archie's sent their oversized mascot to join in and spread awareness about the work that they do for local children and families. Of course, this made for some great photo opportunities for all our Foundation friends.

All in all, the celebrity appearances and interactive elements made the stand a real talking-point, says Alan. "Instead of the usual quiet mumbling, the sounds coming from our stand were laughter and cheering. Hundreds of people were trying to get the ball into the net, from engineers to schoolkids."

The stand created an excellent response at the exhibition for all the right reasons. "We're a relatively new company, so it was great to see how many people had already heard of TEXO," says Alan. "We had people coming up to say they're proud to be customers of TEXO because of what we do for the local schools and Archie's. And others asking how they could get to work for TEXO – it was an emotional day."

Alan and the TEXO team have been overwhelmed by the heartfelt response, throughout the event and afterwards. Visitors commented on TEXO's "shining example" and one even told us, *"I wish my company does half of what TEXO does for the community!"*. Another visitor wrote, *"Game changing! Never seen any company do so much for the communities it's based in."*

TEXO EMPLOYEE DONATES AWARD WINNINGS TO HELP YOUNG COLLEAGUE

TEXO has a multimillion pound fabrication and assembly project ongoing at Blyth, for a company called Large Diameter Drilling (LDD), who are part of the Acteon Group. For the project duration, LDD management have put in place an incentive award program based on locally submitted observation cards / ideas matter opinions.

The incentive scheme, which is funded by LDD, grants award winning TEXO personnel with a weekly voucher of £20.00, culminating in a monthly winner receiving a £50.00 voucher. Weekly winners are selected by an HSE committee that comprises of a varying level of personnel from TEXO, LDD and Saipem, who then elect a monthly winner from the weekly winners chosen during that month.
