End-to-End Maintenance, Repair and Support

TEXO provides comprehensive inspection, repair and maintenance services, including preventative maintenance programmes, winterisation, equipment overhaul and long-term preservation solutions. These capabilities are complemented by specialist offshore accommodation, HVAC and refrigeration services, alongside modification and improvement works designed to extend asset life.

Clients also benefit from a range of on-site support facilities at Blyth, including offices and meeting rooms, plant and equipment hire, scaffolding and access solutions, secure storage, rope access, and survey and inspection services — all supported by TEXO Recruitment.



Advanced Fabrication and Quayside Infrastructure


At the core of the Blyth facility is a **2,200m²** fully equipped fabrication workshop, featuring dual 20-tonne overhead cranes, oversized access doors and dedicated quayside handling. This is supported by multiple commercial quays across South Harbour, SUF Terminal, Bates Terminal and Battleship Wharf, making the site ideal for subsea spreads, cable handling and offshore construction projects.

TEXO's mobilisation and demobilisation hub is fully equipped to support vessels of all sizes, with seamless movement of equipment between fabrication, storage, maintenance and quayside zones.



Heavy and Complex Lifting Expertise


TEXO delivers trusted heavy and complex lifting operations, with on-site cranes ranging from **124 to 600 tonnes**, certified rigging stores, forklift hire up to 32 tonnes and heavy-lift transport. Projects are underpinned by detailed lift planning, RAMS and engineering assurance, with additional support for wet testing, commissioning and complex jacking or tilt operations — all delivered with full compliance.



Turnkey Quayside and Vessel Support

The Blyth base offers 24/7 access to deep-water quays and heavy-strengthened load-out areas capable of roll-on/roll-off operations up to **3,000 tonnes**. TEXO provides full turnkey quayside support, including project planning, fabrication of grillages and sea-fastenings, transportation, testing and certification.


On-board vessel services include welding, fabrication, static and dynamic load testing, with class-approved services available where required — creating a streamlined solution for offshore construction, subsea, cable and energy markets.



Certified Fabrication Capability

TEXO's fabrication services are backed by **Lloyd's Register-approved weld procedures**, covering a wide range of materials including carbon steel, high-strength steels, duplex, stainless steel and specialist alloys. Fabrication capabilities span offshore and subsea structures such as grillages, storage reels and baskets, carousels, subsea vehicles, A-frames, handling systems and protection structures, as well as onshore industrial steelwork, pipework and access systems.

All TEXO fabrication sites operate under **5S lean disciplines**, ensuring consistent quality, efficiency and safety.


