

Reel partition fabrication at Port of Blyth

Our client

As our Port Services division has a significant facility at Port of Blyth, we regularly work in partnership with the Port Authority to offer critical engineering and fabrication services to its own clients. On this occasion, we were contracted to work on a project a global leader in delivering offshore projects in the energy market. This project had a renewable energy focus – an area of work that is growing quickly at TEXO.

We were asked to remove the existing reel partitions, and to fabricate and install new partitions.

The solution

Removing the existing partitions was a challenge because of tight access and challenging weather conditions.

The size of the required reels meant that we had to proceed carefully, ensuring accuracy at every stage. We maintained straightness and levelness using certified lasers and Dumpy levels to ensure that the fabrication was precise – and right first time.

During installation, we needed to ensure that the ovality of the reel was maintained at all times and that the new partitions backed up all the original stiffening. Both removal and installation was carried out with trained and competent MEWP operators, and we benefitted from access to the high-quality plant equipment and operators working at the Port of Blyth.
