

MODULAR BUILDINGS CASE STUDY BUCKSBURN ACADEMY, ABERDEEN

Bucksburn Academy needed a rapid expansion without the delays and site disruption associated with traditional construction. The event welcomed a remarkable group of students from St Cuthbert's School, who displayed incredible dedication by cycling all the way from North Shields in Newcastle to Blyth.

During the session, TEXO proudly showcased its cutting-edge innovations in the renewable energy sector, highlighting both current and future projects. The students were particularly captivated by demonstrations of drone technology, tidal turbine systems, and subsea vehicles. The enthusiasm and curiosity from both the pupils and their teachers made for a truly memorable and engaging experience.

The impact of the event extended far beyond the day itself. Inspired by TEXO's presentation, the students, already participants in a LEGO Engineering competition, completely reimagined their project.
